Grades given are based upon daily work, final examinations, and/or other written assignments. Characterization of letter grades are without the use of a (+) or (-).

Although Quality Points are not listed on the transcript, they are used to determine if a student graduated with honors. The GPA (Grade Point Average) may be computed by dividing the total number of credit hours completed within each program into the total number of grade points earned.

To be eligible for an honor certificate, the student must achieve a grade point average based on the following scale:

Summa Cum Laude 3.91 – 4.0 GPA

Magna Cum Laude 3.75 – 3.90 GPA

Cum Laude 3.5 – 3.784 GPA

For a scholastic medallion, the student must achieve a 4.0 GPA plus # 2 & 3 below.

To be eligible for cords, the student must achieve: 1) the required grade point average (4.0), 2) attend the graduation ceremony, 3) have all fees / monies paid and all work completed by May 15th, 2007

The student's program must be no less than 32 semester hours of actual course work (in-service projects and portfolio assessment credits are not included). Students not attending graduation are still eligible to receive Honor Certificates, but not the scholastic medallion. (Those receiving a medallion do not receive cords).
